Favorite Highlight or Moment in Your Career: One highlight of my career thus far came in a Hatch-Waxman litigation in Delaware district court. My firm represented a generic manufacturer whose case initially lagged behind those of several competitors. We briefed a new claim construction issue that the other defendants had not presented, and we ended up in a combined *Markman* hearing. I had the opportunity to explain our position and persuaded the Court to adopt our claim construction despite rejecting the other defendants' constructions. That success supported a strong non-infringement argument for my client.

Practice Tips/Best Advice Received: Your career is a marathon, not a sprint. It's important to sustain it by finding great colleagues and cases that are important to you and learning all you can along the way.
