Associate Gary Prato will present a session titled "From Synthetic Chemist to Patent Attorney" at the American Chemical Society (ACS) Fall 2023 conference taking place August 13-17, 2023, in San Francisco, California. Gary's session will take place on the first day of the conference, August 13.

Gary will discuss the patent area of intellectual property, including what is a patent, why patents are important to a company, and how he helps his clients obtain a patent.
